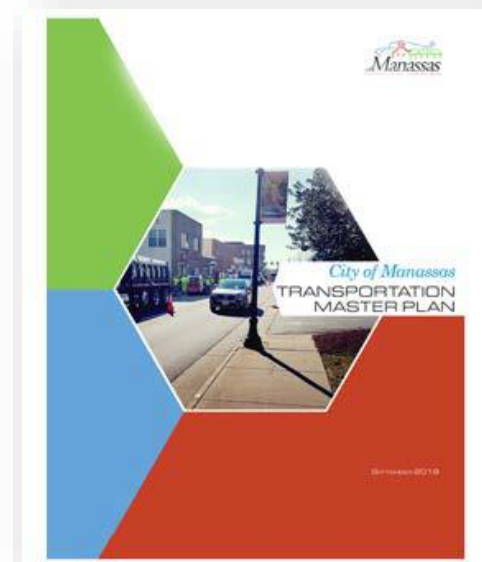

Pedestrian Network Plan



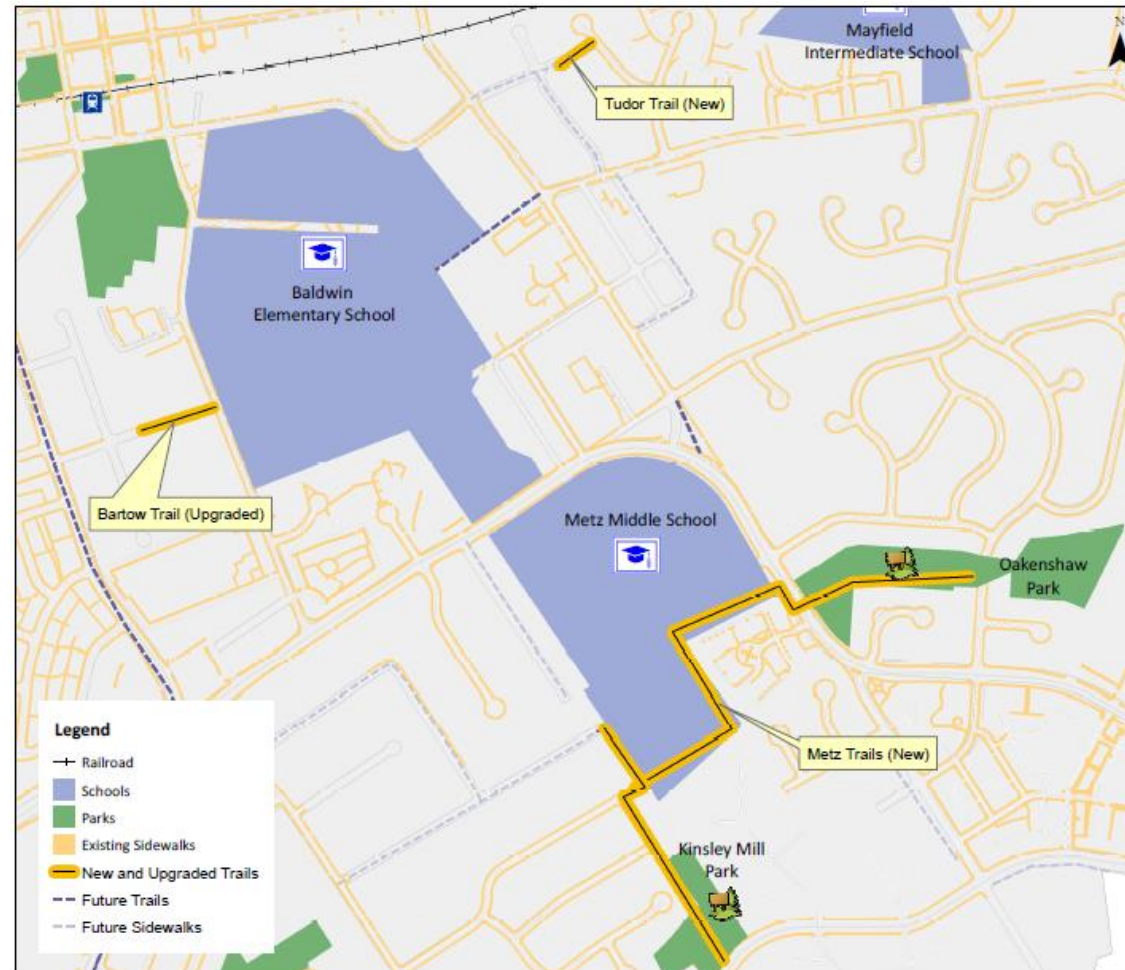
Recently completed bike & pedestrian initiatives

- 11 miles of bike facilities (trail, bike lanes, sharrows) were added in FY19 & FY20 as part of CIP and paving program
- Bike friendly station in parking garage – Fall 2020
- Portner sidewalk from Sudley Rd. to Longstreet Dr.

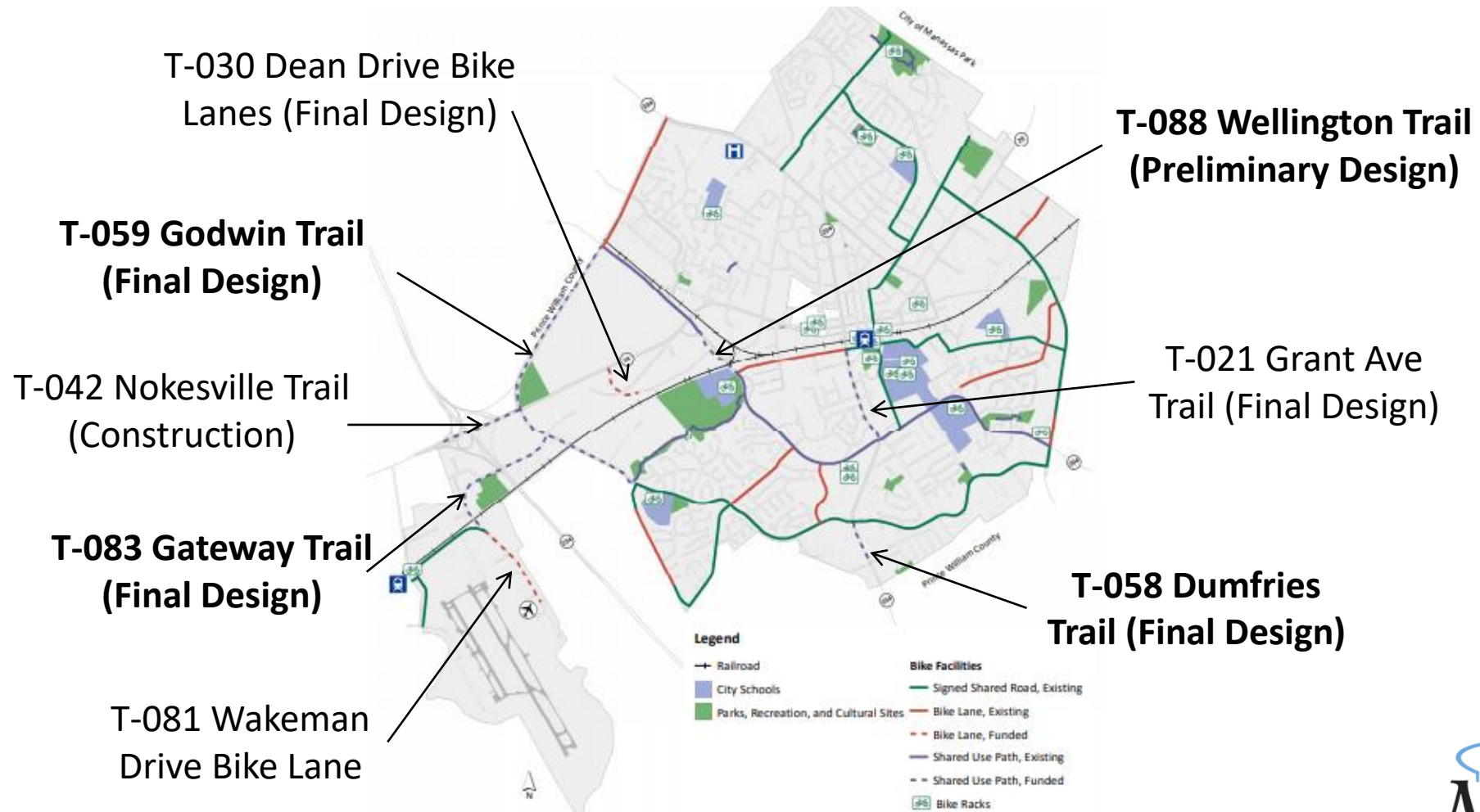


Recently completed bike and pedestrian initiatives

- Transportation Master Plan (TMP) Walkshed analysis
- 0.5 mile of upgraded and new trails
- Connections to 3 schools and 2 parks

Dumfries Road Shared Use Path

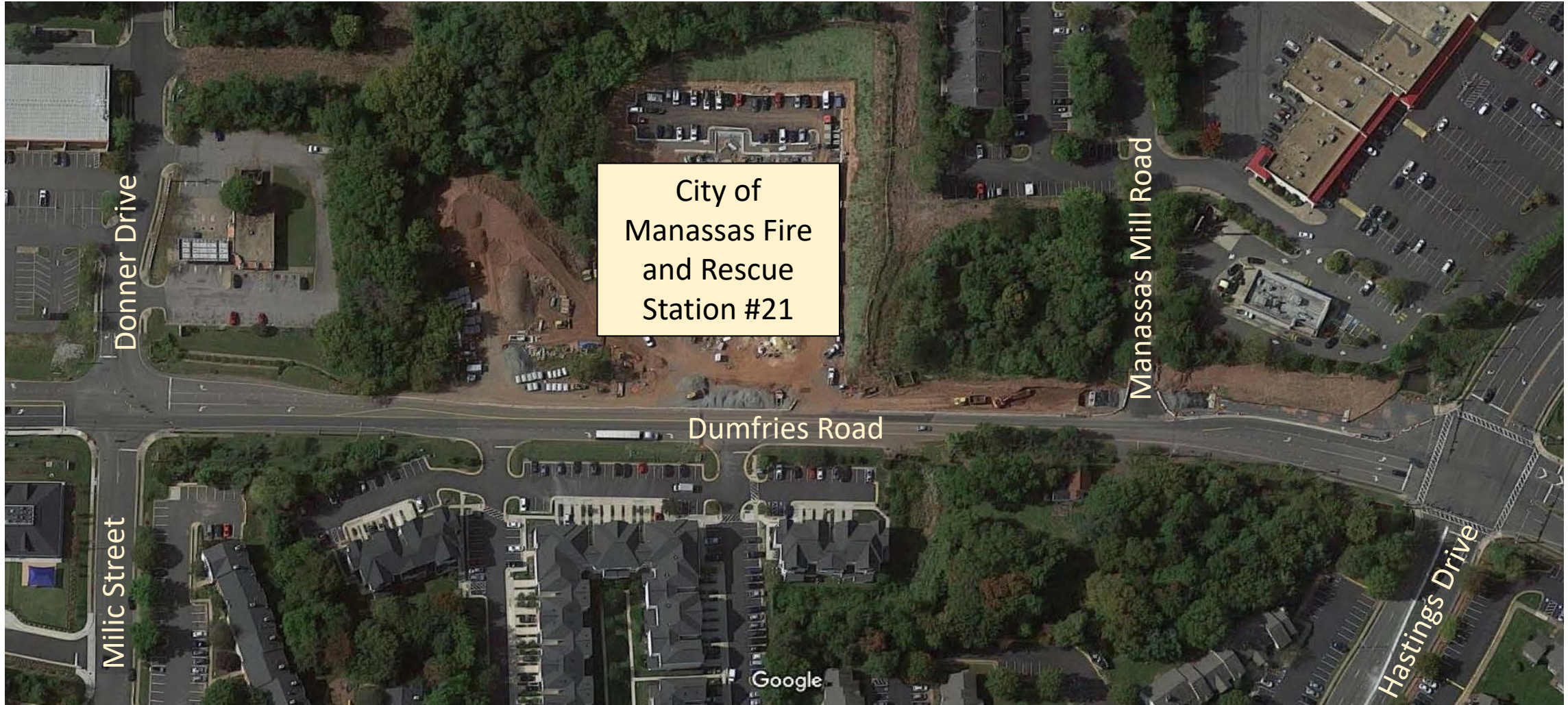


- New 10-foot wide, 1600 linear foot shared-use trail on the east-side of Dumfries Road between Hastings Drive and Donner Drive.
- Storm drainage improvements.
- Increased pedestrian and bicycle safety.
- Sidewalk connection to the new 9600 block City of Manassas Fire and Rescue Station #21.
- Project Cost: \$1.1M
- Estimated Construction Start: Summer 2021

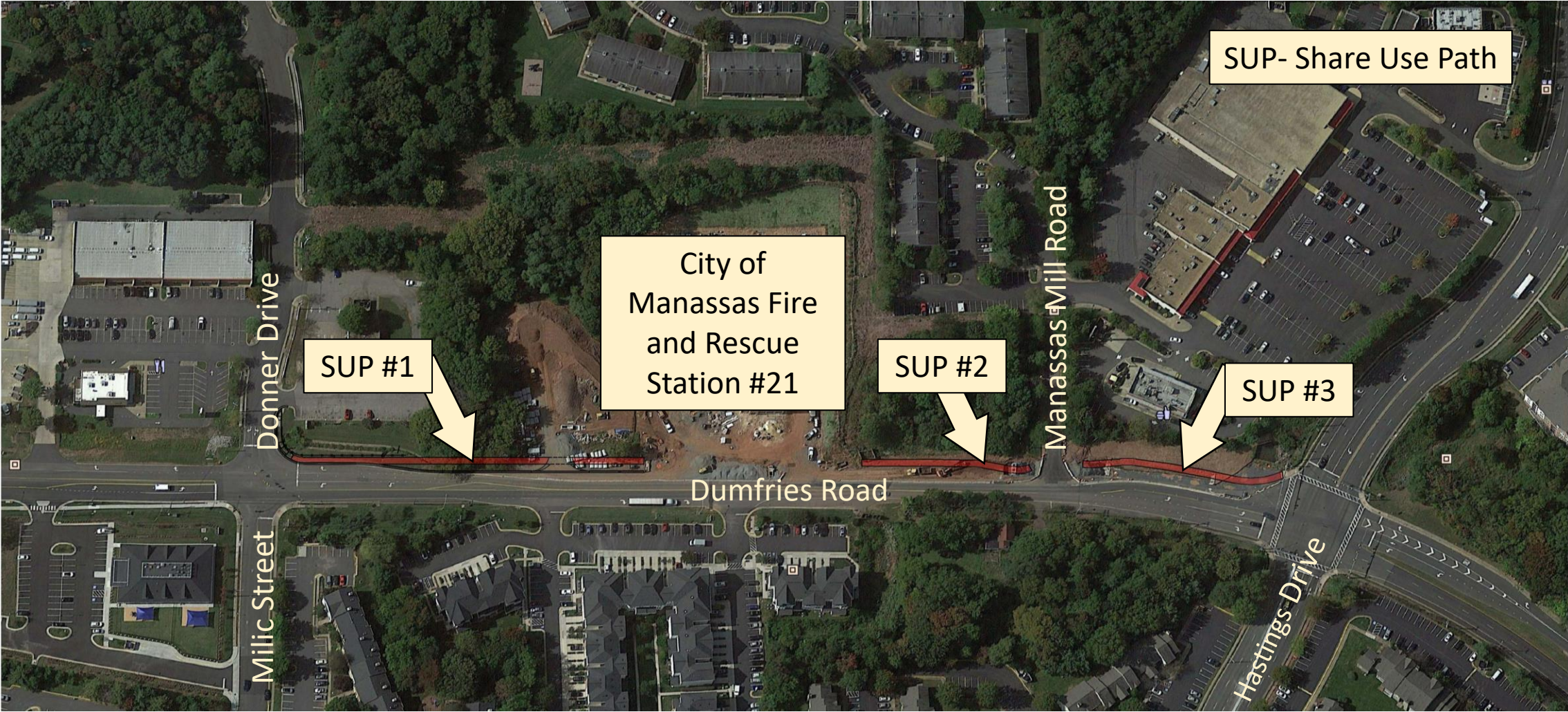

Gateway Blvd Sidewalk and Trail



- New ADA compliant 2,332 linear feet, 10—foot wide shared-use trail along the north-side of Gateway Boulevard.
- New ADA compliant 2,332 linear feet, 5—foot wide sidewalk along the south-side of Gateway Boulevard.
- Increased pedestrian and bicycle safety.
- New walking and biking connections for residents and businesses in the Gateway/Airport area.
- Project Cost: \$740,000
- Estimated Construction Start: Fall 2021

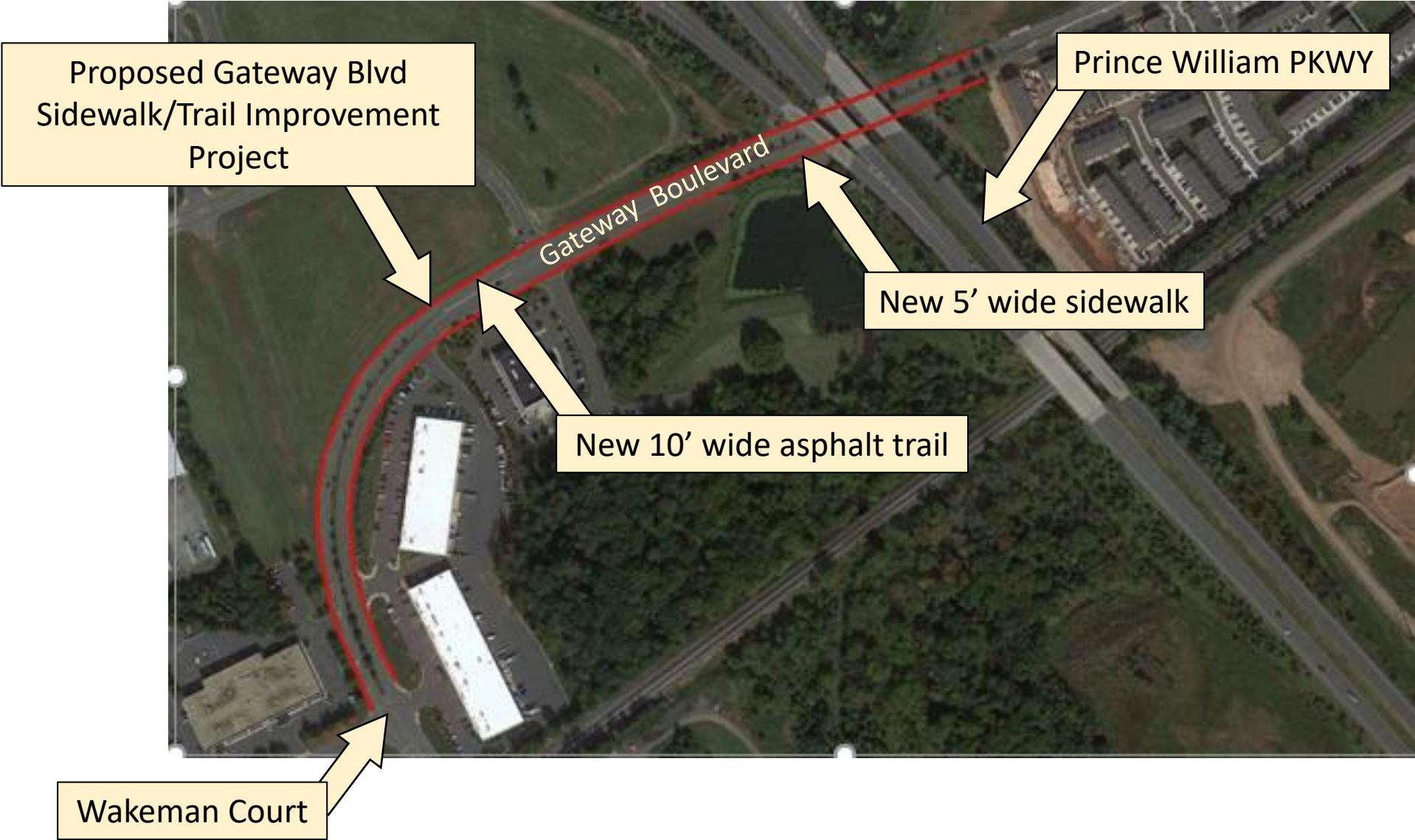

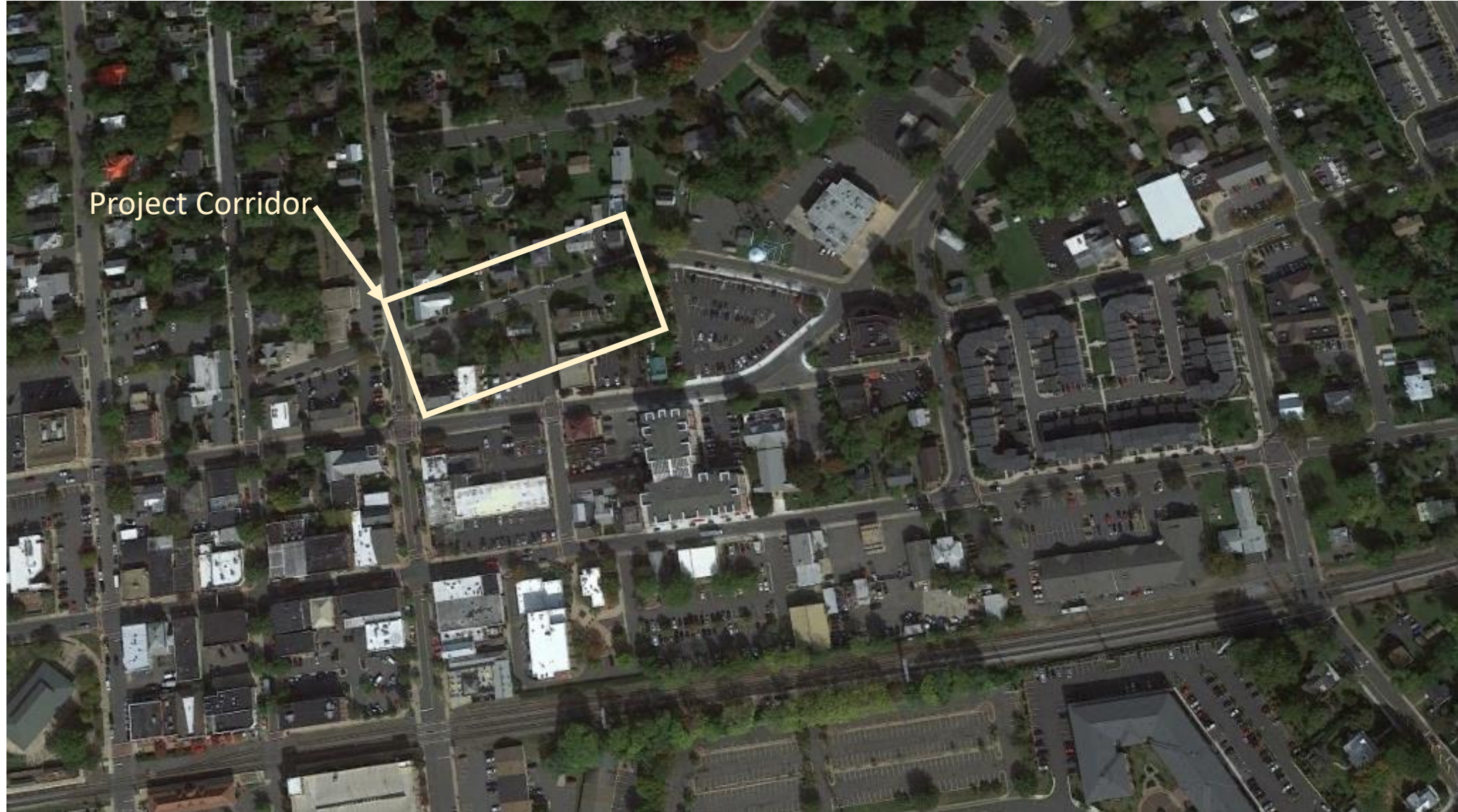


Quarry Street Streetscape

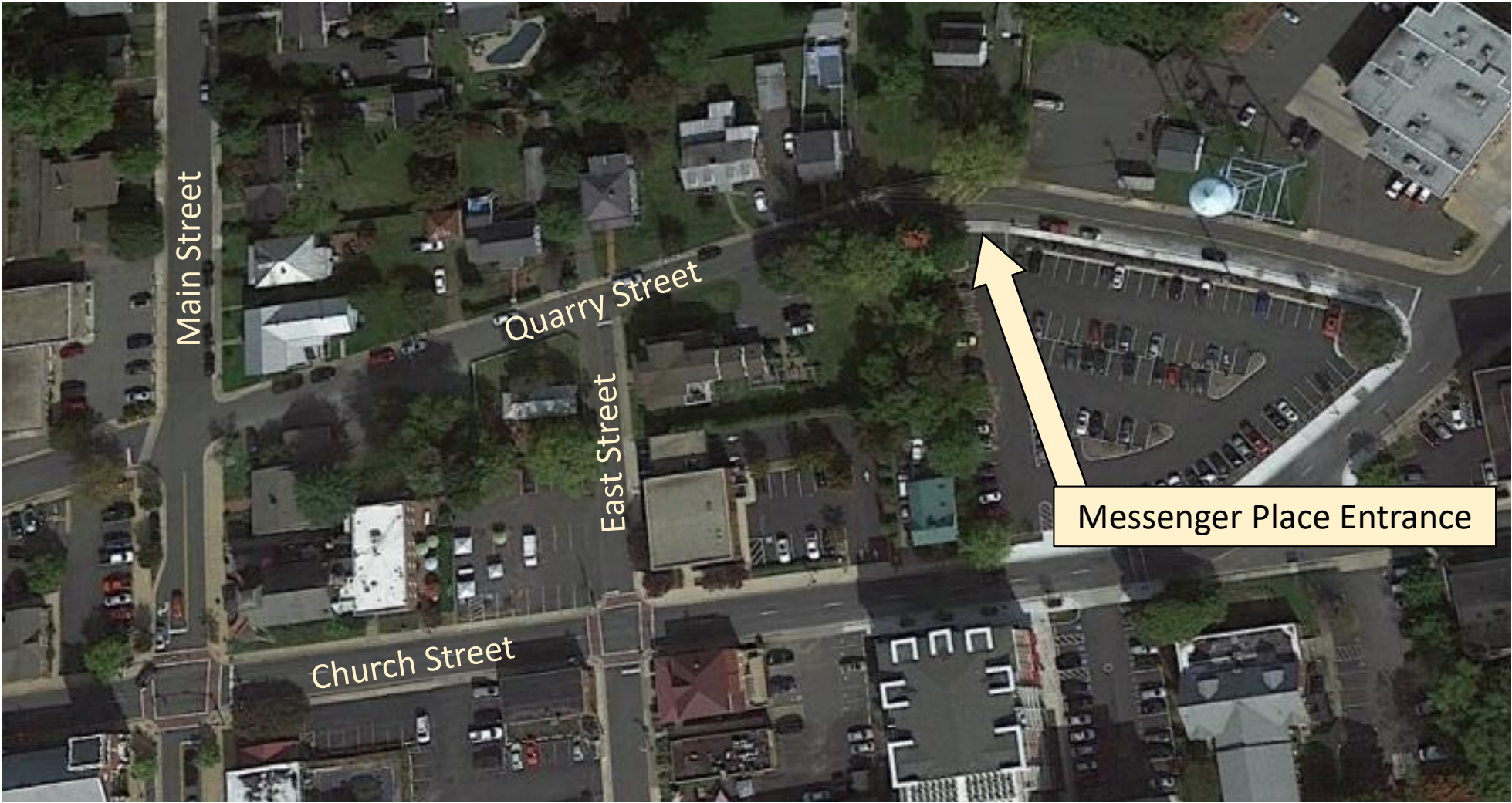


- New ADA compliant 5—foot wide sidewalk along the southern portion of Quarry Street.
- This project will replace the existing 4-foot wide sidewalk along the north-side of Quarry Street.
- New roadway pavement, approximately 450 linear feet, between Main Street and the Messenger Place entrance.
- FYI- Project area utility undergrounding will be completed before this project begins.
- Project Cost: \$1M
- Estimated Construction Start: Fall 2021

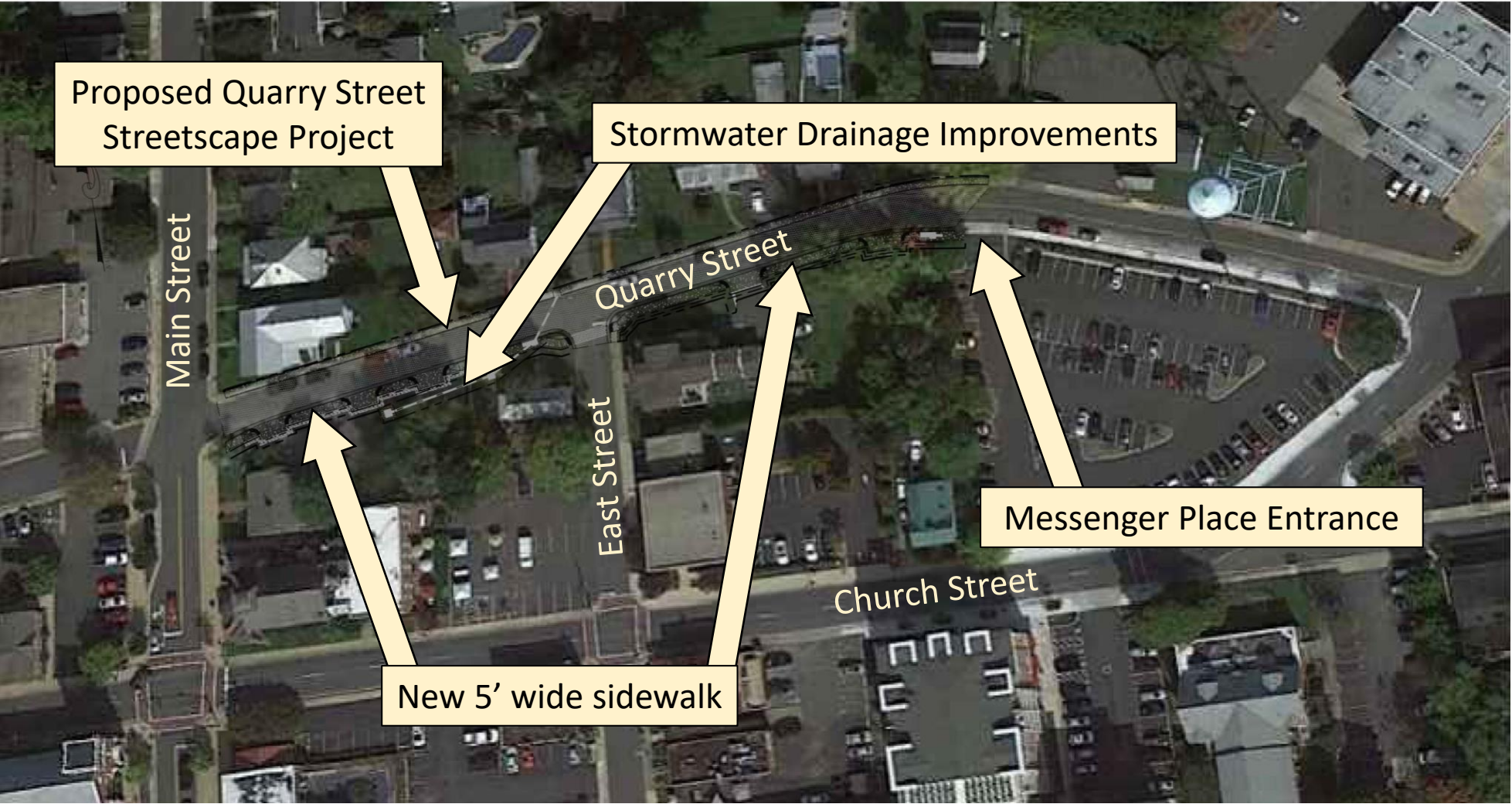

Godwin Drive Shared-Use Path



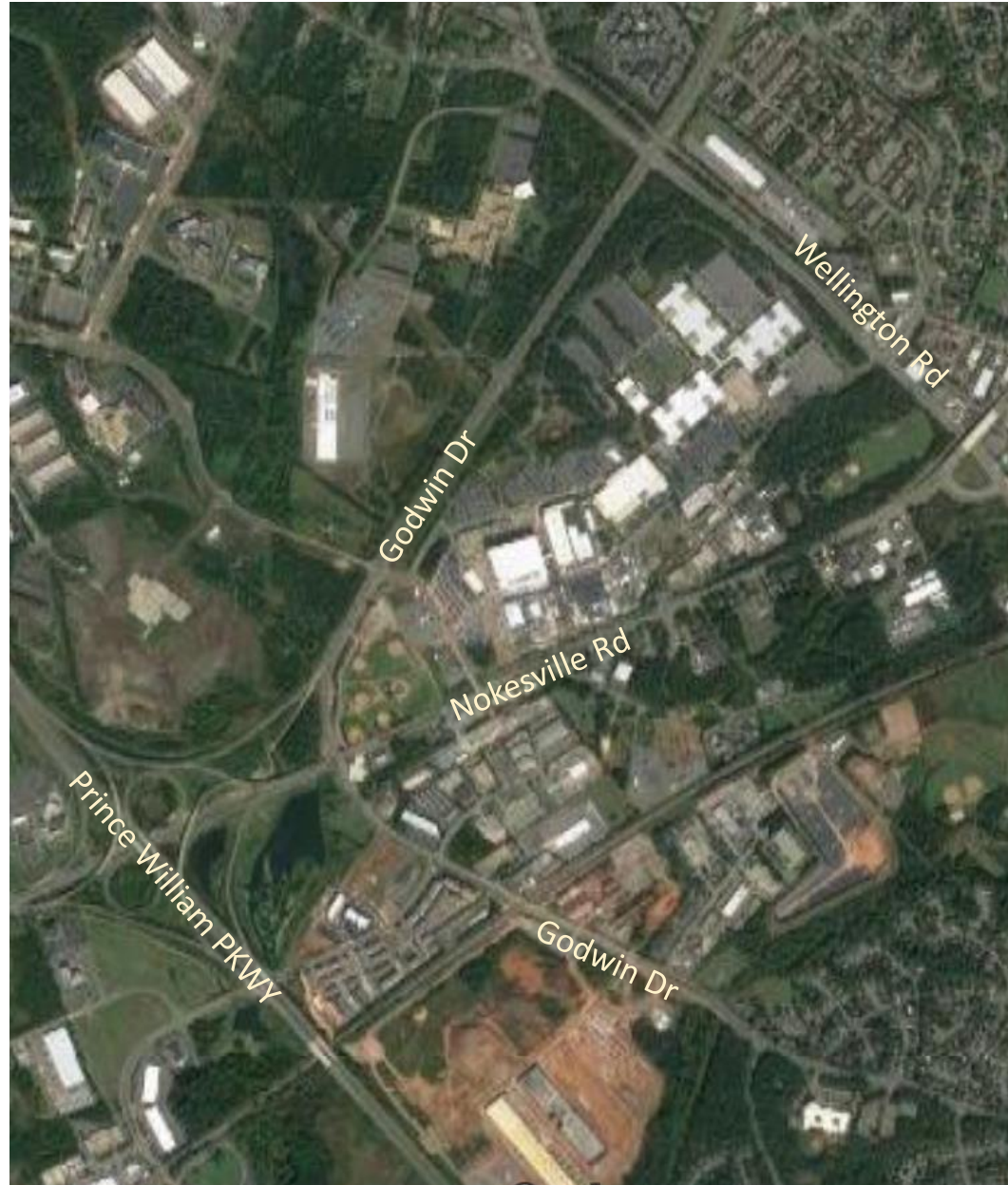
- Project Design
 - Two-way bicycle and pedestrian shared use path (8'-10' wide)
 - From Wellington Road to Winters Branch Trail (approx. 1.5 miles)
- Project Cost: \$1.7M
- Project Schedule
 - Right-of-way Acquisition: Summer 2021
 - Construction is anticipated to begin in Fall 2021.

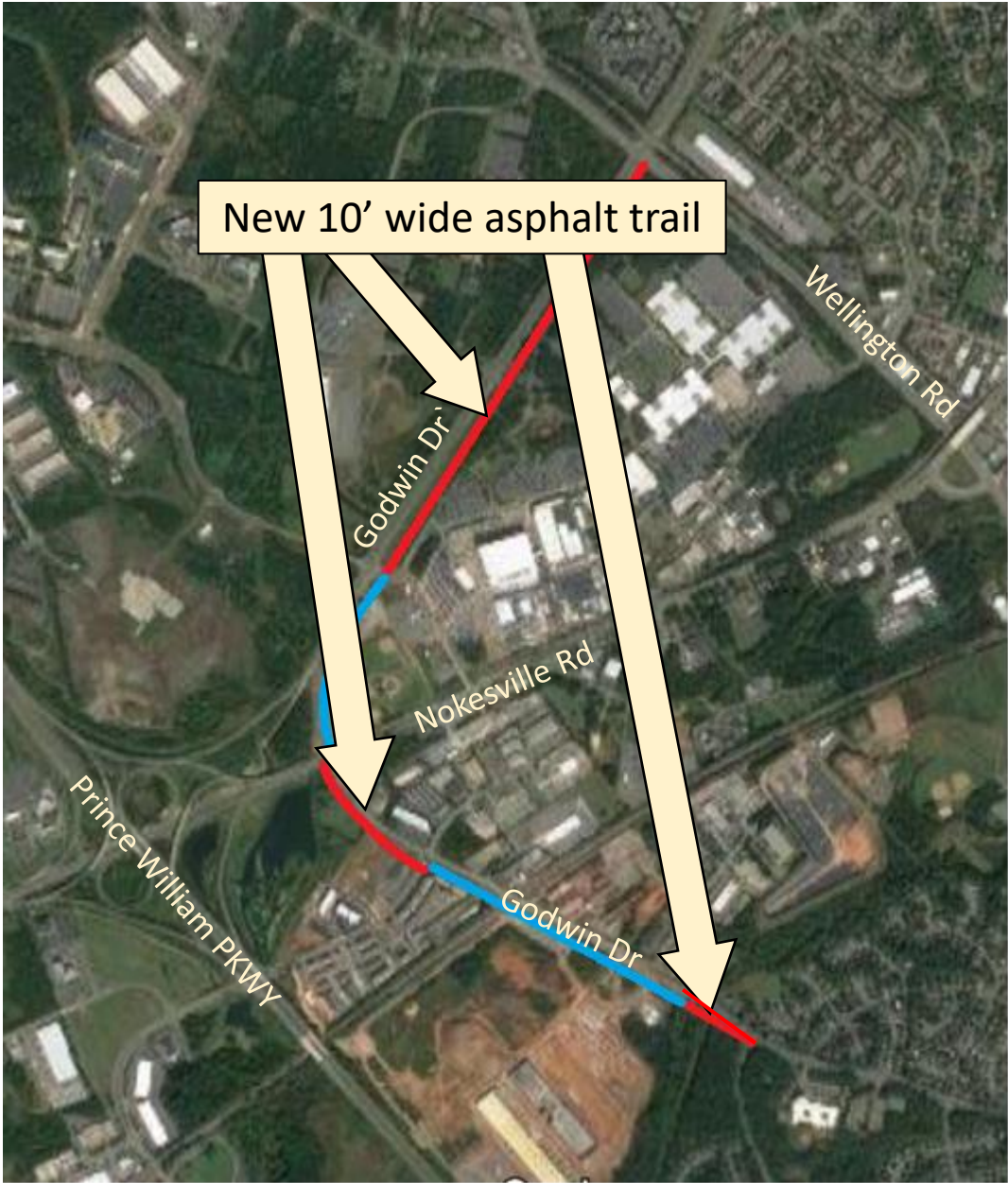

Wellington Trail



- Project Design
 - 10' wide Shared Use Path between Nokesville Road Access Road and Prince William Street
 - Approx. 1,800' in length
 - Two At-Grade Railroad Crossings
- Project Cost: \$1M
- Project Schedule
 - Design Start: Summer 2021
 - Anticipated Construction Start: Summer 2023

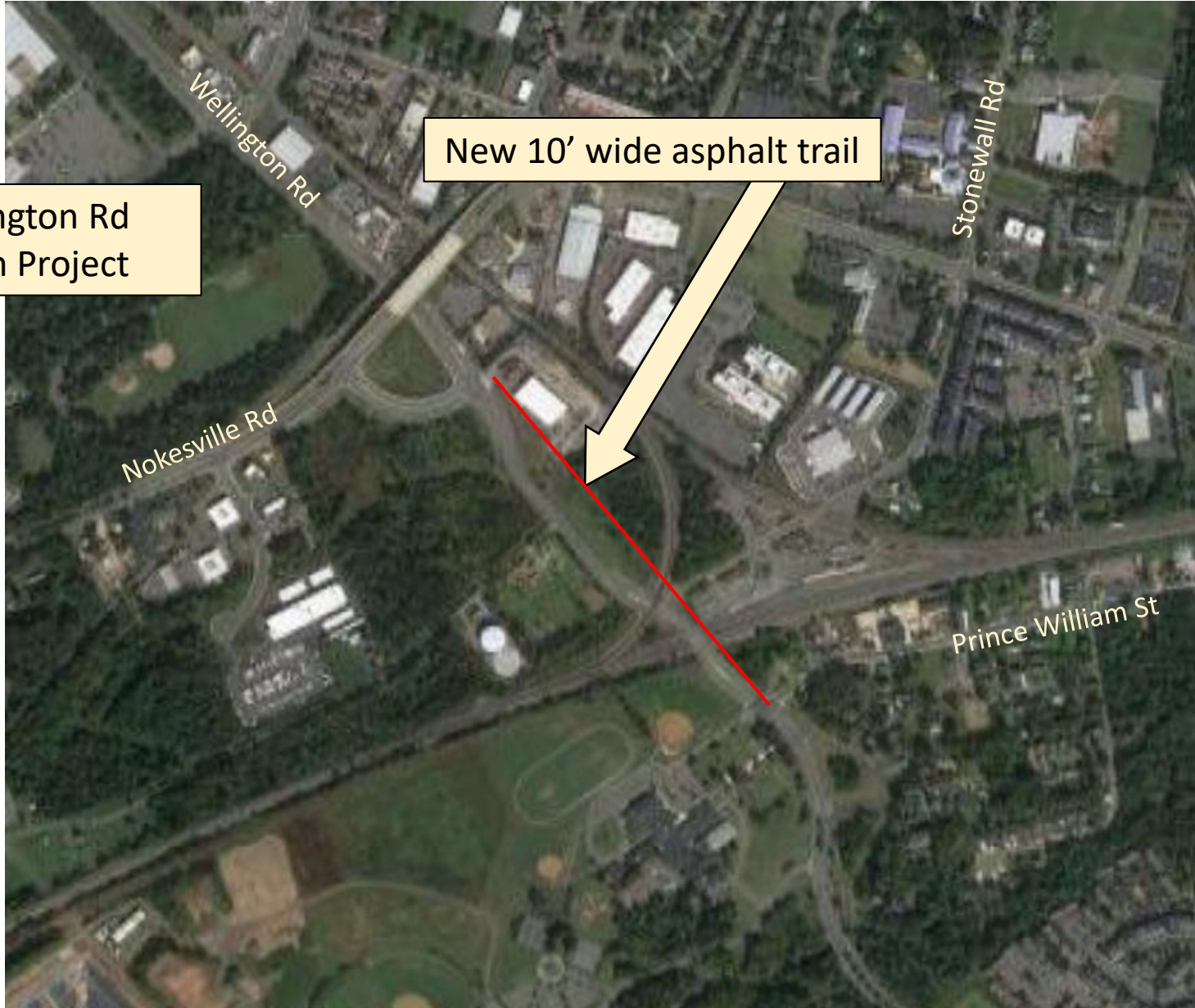
