CHALLENGE your skill on the rails, ramps, and jumps at the skate park located in Dean Park.

EXPLORE the many trails to ride a bike or take a walk and enjoy the sounds of nature in one of the many parks. Trails are located in Cannon Branch Fort, Dean Park, Kinsley Mill Park, Liberia House and Grounds, Nelson Park, Oakenshaw Park, and Stonewall Park.

PLAY and climb at one of the many playgrounds. Let your imagination guide the fun on the rocket ship at Kinsley Mill Park, find the sea serpent at Byrd Park, or take a ride on the dinosaur in Cavalry Run Park.

SKATE in a game of roller hockey or play a game of futsal on the multi-use courts at Kinsley Mill Park, Byrd Park, Lee Manor Park, or Stonewall Park. Courts are lined for roller hockey and futsal but are open to other outdoor sports on a hard surface.

BOUNCE a basketball on the courts at Byrd Park, Cavalry Run Park, Kinsley Mill Park, Oakenshaw Park, Stonewall Park, and Wintersset Park. Try out the Bankshot Basketball Court at Byrd Park.

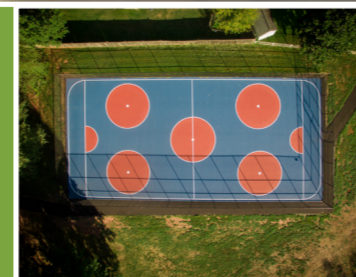

PERFECT your swing on tennis courts around the City. Courts are lined for pickleball at Metz Middle School, Osbourn High School, Cavalry Run Park, Dean Park, and Lee Manor Park. Permanent pickleball courts are available at Stonewall Park.



STRENGTHEN your muscles on the adult fitness equipment at Byrd Park and Cavalry Run Park. Fitness stations include equipment for upper body and abdominal strength training.

EXERCISE with your dog in Lucky's Dog Park at Dean Park. Just under an acre in size, the dog park has fenced areas for both small and large dogs, water fountains, obstacles, dog washing station, shade, and benches.

CAST a fishing line in the catch and release pond at Cannon Branch Fort.

JUMP into the Stonewall Park Pool during the summer. The pool is open annually from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Bring a swimsuit to enjoy the 6 lane pool and spray ground.

GLIDE across the ice on skates at the Harris Pavilion in the winter. The rink is open from mid-November to March (weather permitting).

FOLLOW the history trail signs around downtown, at Liberia House and Grounds, and Mayfield Fort to learn more about the local history of Manassas. Trail maps are available at the *Manassas Museum. *Reopening July 2023.

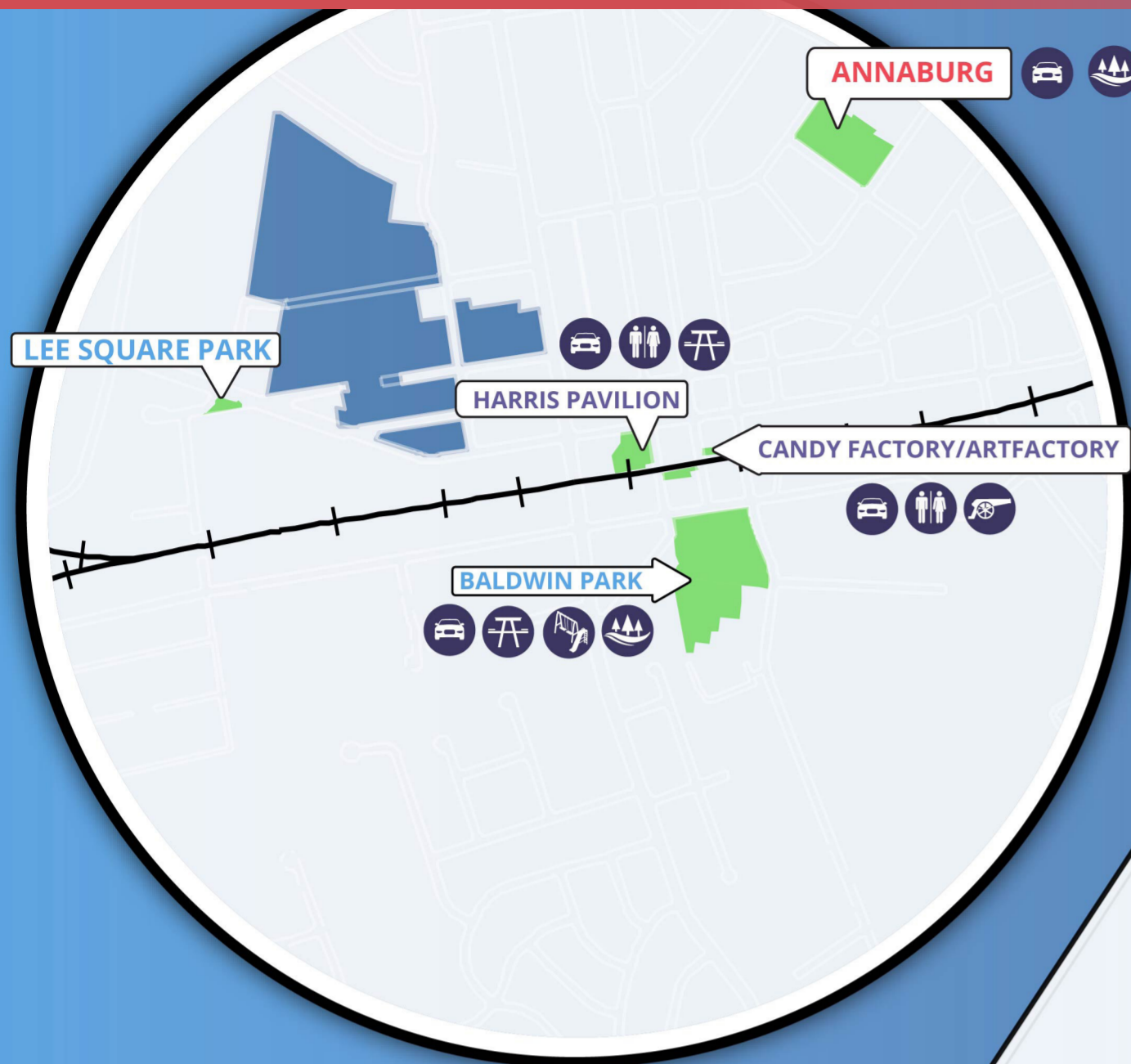
