Subject: Prince William Street Update and Citizens Meeting

Dear Residents:

The City of Manassas would like to update our residents on the Prince William Street Project. This road widening improvement project is part of the City's Capital Improvement Plan. Work includes the installation of curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and bike lanes. Water mains will also be upsized to increase water quality, fire protection and reliability of service. A portion of old sanitary sewer mains will be replaced to increase reliability by reducing blockages and defects. New and larger diameter storm pipes are also proposed to provide drainage improvements. It is anticipated that the road improvements portion of this project will go to construction later this summer.

The work on Prince William Street over the past two years is related to utility relocations (under grounding electric, Comcast and Verizon; and replacing an old Colombia Gas line) that needed to be completed in advance of the start of the road improvements. This utility work is about 90% complete with the final phase of gas relocation currently underway. While the utility work is being accomplished, the City's engineering consultant is finalizing the engineering plans for the roadway improvements. The plans are nearing completion and City staff would like to meet with property owners to go over the proposed improvements and to get your feedback.

Please join us on May 11, 2017 (Thursday), from 6 to 8 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 9027 Center Street, to discuss the Prince William Street project. Staff will present information on the project and solicit your feedback.
