HUTTON, JAMES.—Age, 28 years. Enlisted, May 2, 1861, at Rochester, to serve two years; mustered in as private, Co. H, May 21, 1861; transferred, April 1, 1862, to Co. I; mustered out with company, May 28, 1863, at Utica, N. Y.; subsequent service in First Veteran Cavalry.

INGERSOLL, FRANCIS M.—Age, 28 years. Enlisted, May 1, 1861, at Utica, to serve two years; mustered in as private, Co. A, May 21, 1861; appointed wagoner, August 8, 1861; deserted, January 27, 1862, at Fort Ellsworth, Va.

INGERSOLL, FRANK D., see Frank D. Engersoll.

ITTINGER, STEPHEN.—Age, 22 years. Enlisted, September 10, 1861, at Buffalo, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, same date; mustered out with company, May 28, 1863, at Utica, N. Y.

JACKSON, WILLIAM.—Age, 18 years. Enlisted, May 3, 1861, at Utica, to serve two years; mustered in as private, Co. C, May 21, 1861; died of disease, November 27, 1861, in Seventh New York Brigade Hospital, Alexandria, Va.

JAMES, EDWARD.—Age, date and place of enlistment not stated; commissioned second lieutenant, date not stated, with rank from May 1, 1861, original; not mustered.

JAMISON, WILLIAM.—Age, 34 years. Enlisted, August 4, 1861, at Rochester, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. A, August 9, 1861; wounded, August 31, 1862, at Bull Run, Va.; discharged for disability, December 14, 1862, at Baltimore, Md.

JENNINGS, CHARLES E.—Age, 34 years. Enrolled, May 2, 1861, at Rochester, to serve two years; mustered in as captain, in Co. G, May 21, 1861; wounded, August 30, 1862, at Groveton, Va.; died of wounds, October 1, 1862, at Washington, D. C.; commissioned captain, July 4, 1861, with rank from May 18, 1861, original.

JENNINGS, GILBERT S.—Age, 44 years. Enrolled, May 2, 1861, at Elmira, to serve two years; mustered in as captain, Co. G, May 21, 1861; as major, May 21, 1861; as lieutenant-colonel, September 20, 1862; wounded, December 16-17, 1862, at Fredericksburg, Va.; mustered out with regiment, May 28, 1863, at Utica, N. Y.; commissioned captain, date not stated, with rank from May 2, 1861, original; major, June 20, 1861, with rank from May 17, 1861, original; lieutenant-colonel, November 25, 1862, with rank from September 19, 1862, vice Richardson, promoted.
